## **Flower Chart for 2021 is up**

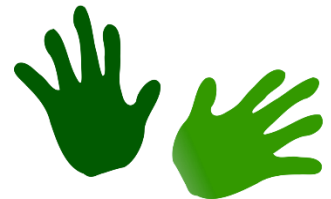

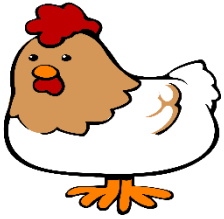

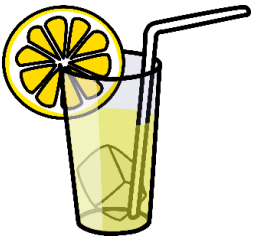
## New Book Clubs Starting this summer
