Flower Chart for 2021 is up

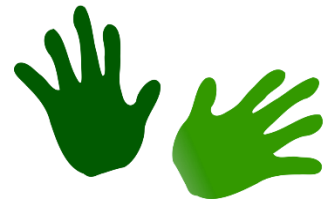

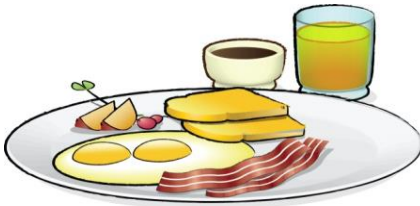


NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

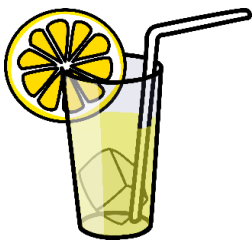


New Book Clubs Starting this summer
