From the Stewardship Committee

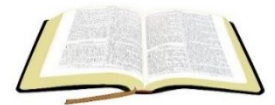

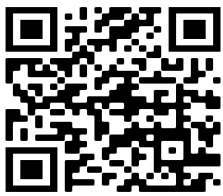

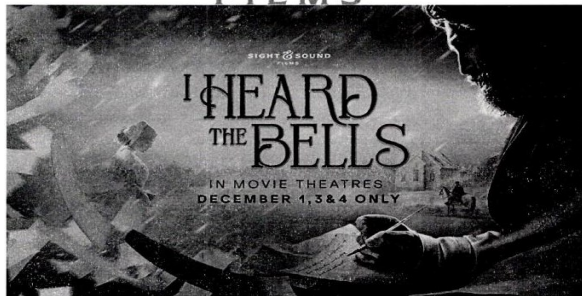
