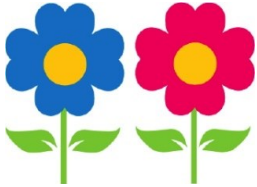
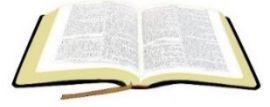


REQUEST FOR LITURGISTS
