

Eclipse Glasses Give Back: We are often asked what to do with used eclipse glasses after an eclipse. Eclipse Glasses USA works with other organizations to **donate** used but undamaged eclipse glasses to other countries with upcoming eclipse events. We only accept US-made paperboard glasses that have the manufacturer's address

and contact info and that bear the ISO logo. All others will be discarded due to liability and quality issues. Bring your glasses to church for the Mission/Outreach to send them onto a school in Latin America, where there will be an annular eclipse in October 2024.
