From the Stewardship Committee

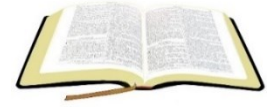

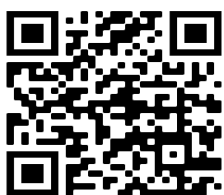
