The Morning Scripture Lesson: Psalms 1:1-6 & 2:1-12

<sup>1</sup>Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, <sup>2</sup> but whose delight is in the law of the LORD, and who meditates on his law day and night. <sup>3</sup> That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which vields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not witherwhatever they do prospers. <sup>4</sup> Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away. <sup>5</sup> Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment. nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous. <sup>6</sup> For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked leads to destruction.

- <sup>9</sup>You will break them with a rod of iron<sup>[b]</sup>; you will dash them to pieces like pottery."
- <sup>10</sup> Therefore, you kings, be wise; be warned, you rulers of the earth.
- <sup>11</sup> Serve the LORD with fear and celebrate his rule with trembling.
- <sup>12</sup> Kiss his son, or he will be angry and your way will lead to your destruction,
- for his wrath can flare up in a moment. Blessed are all who take refuge in him.
