

Dear Members & Friends of Trinity Presbyterian Church,

Perhaps one of the most meaningful Gospel passages for me is the one where Jesus asks Peter following the resurrection, Do you love me? He asks this question three times over. When Peter says yes, each time, Jesus reminds him, Feed my sheep! Interestingly, nowhere does it say anything in the Scriptures about the "diet" of the sheep. And today, as we look around the communal life of the church, we discover that there are various tastes and needs of folks who are part of "the flock". Just as our physical, mental, and emotional requirements differ from person to person, likewise, so do our spiritual needs vary from one person to another.

While some of our Trinity family of faith are fed at Sunday morning services of worship and prayer, others enjoy being fed at special fellowship events that highlight fun, food, and friendship. Some are centered in Holy Communion, others in Scripture, and others in service to the Session or Deacons. All of these, I believe, along with many other aspects of our Christian faith and witness are valid, and each committed Christian can enjoy any combination of food from that spiritual menu at any time throughout his or her spiritual journey.

When one earnestly studies either the Old Testament or the New Testament, it soon becomes abundantly clear "spiritual variety" is not lacking anywhere among God's chosen people. Hence, it evermore seems to me that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord can and should minister to those around him or her no matter their background. All believers alike, I think, have been called to spread the Gospel and to minister in his name wherever they find themselves in God's world. Here in the heart of Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, we, as a vital part of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) should



The regular meeting of the Session was held on April 18, 2023, at Trinity Presbyterian Church, Dallas, PA. The following items were discussed and acted upon by the Session.

- After completing confirmation classes, Grayson Michael McKinley was accepted into membership of Trinity Presbyterian Church on April 16, 2023. The Session sends their congratulations to Grayson and welcomes him into membership at Trinity.
- At the request of Montview Presbyterian Boulevard Church, Denver, Colorado Trinity transferred the membership of Carol Vanstory to their church. Carol was a very active member of Trinity and will be missed.
- 3. The Annual Statistical Report to the General Assembly dated March 22, 2023 was sent to the Presbytery indicating our membership at 99 active members.
- 4. April 11, 2023 was Administrative Professionals Day. The Session wishes to extend our appreciation to Nicole Fleschut for her hard work and dedication to Trinity. Rev. Dr. Thompson took her to lunch to show our appreciation.
- 5. Rev. Dr. Murray Thompson submitted his report for the period 1 March 18 April, 2023 reflecting:
 - a) One hospital visit.
 - b) Three home visits.
 - c) Thirteen contacts
 - d) Nine meetings with committees, members, and church services
 - e) Correspondence 45 to members and friends of Trinity
 - f) Provided spiritual guidance to the American Legion at Memorial Services
 - g) Attended Committee on Ministry on February 23, 2023
- 6. Rev. Dr. Murray Thompson indicated that, as part of his ministry, Karin and he appreciate the opportunity to visit with members of the congregation in their homes. The visits provide them with the

opportunity to have some quality time with the members of the congregation.

- 7. Rev. Thompson advised the Session that the Board of Deacons has divided the congregation into groups of five or six members. One deacon will be assigned to each of the groups. They will keep in contract with their group providing any assistance that may be necessary for the good health of the congregation.
- 8. Elder Karen Perzia reported that in the annual report she indicated that we would have a deficit of approximate \$15,860.00. Since the beginning of this year members of the congregation have donated \$3,695.00 to the heating fund, \$500.00 to the hoagie fund and \$400.00 to the Mother's Day Memorial Fund. This leaves a balance of approximately \$11,265.00. The revenue from the rummage fund generally results in a donation of \$4,000.00.

9. BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS COMMITTEE

a. Elder Wayne Williams advised that Harry Rosecrans has submitted an estimate of \$4,800.00 to make the repairs to the parking lot.
b. Thanks to Wayne Williams, the trees that were in need of removal have been

cut down.


